

ANTD.VN - On November 19, Chairman of Hanoi People's Committee Nguyen Duc Chung had a meeting with Mr. Martin Dulig, Minister of Economy, Labor and Transportation; Deputy Premier of Saxony-Germany.

At the reception, Mr. Martin Dulig thanked the warm welcome of Hanoi and affirmed that Vietnam is developing very strongly. In particular, Hanoi is a bright spot to attract young people and dynamic vitality.

Mr. Martin Dulig shared with Hanoi the challenges of addressing environmental pollution; energy; provide clean energy; waste disposal ... These are the problems that all cities in the world have to face.

Also at the meeting, Chairman Nguyen Duc Chung Hanoi informed the village about the socio-economic situation. Accordingly, Hanoi has a population of nearly 10 million people with an average economic growth rate of 8 years to reach 7.41%.

In 2018, Hanoi expects to welcome 26 million tourists, including 5.7 million foreign tourists. However, along with the rapid development, Hanoi is experiencing a number of major environmental challenges, the quality of clean water supply (which is now the standard of the Ministry of Health Vietnam but not European standards.); pollution in rivers, lakes and ponds in the area; air pollution; traffic jam...

Chairman of the city People's Committee also informed, in the program of socio-economic development in the period 2016-2020, Hanoi has set targets to 2020, the people of Hanoi will be using clean water according to European standards Europe.

In order to achieve the above objectives, in the last 2 years, the city has called for 24 investors to invest in 31 projects, including the Duong River surface water project co-operated by Duong River Joint-stock Company with German business built. After nearly 2 years of implementation, the project has inaugurated the first phase and came into operation with the capacity of 150,000 m³ / day. The project is being implemented in phase 2, raising the capacity to 300, .000 m³ / day in October.

Chairman of the City People's Committee also reviewed the cooperation of Hanoi with Watch Water Company of Germany to produce Redoxy 3C to treat pollution in the rivers and lakes of Hanoi; deployed the project to install more than 100 air monitoring stations. In the area of environmental pollution treatment, Hanoi is also building waste treatment plants with the technology of burning electricity and technology from Germany ... Chairman of Hanoi People's Committee wishes, this trip The minister will help connect with German businesses to learn and promote investment.

Thanks to useful information from Hanoi People's Committee, Mr. Martin Dulig, Deputy Chief of Saxony Federal Republic of Germany, hoped to cooperate with partners of Vietnam as well as Hanoi. Mr. Martin Dulig informed, on November 12, in Leipzig (Germany), the Vietnamese House in Germany was solemnly opened.

This is a place to meet, support the cultural and economic cooperation and exchange and other social activities between the two countries. On this occasion, the Deputy Prime Minister of Saxony-Germany also invited the chairman of the Hanoi People's Committee to visit Germany, especially Leipzig to promote cooperation between the two sides.
